



## Hayward / Cable, WI

# Wisconsin Trail Permit Required!

185 miles northeast of Lakeville, MN  
Approx 3.5 hrs

1. Take 35E North to I-494 East to MN 36 East/WI 35N/WI 64E Somerset (approximately 50.6 miles)
2. Continue onto WI 64 East (approx. 13.8 miles)
3. At the traffic circle take the 2nd exit to follow US Hwy 63 North (Approx, 5 miles)
4. Turn left to stay on US Hwy 63 North (approx. 20.4 miles)
5. Turn right onto US 8 East/US Hwy 63 North (approx. 1.4 miles) at 2nd traffic circle take the 3rd exit to follow US Hwy 63 North (approx. 12 miles)
6. Turn left onto 2nd Avenue (Cumberland, WI) Continue onto Superior Avenue/US Hwy 63 North (approx. 24.2 miles)
7. Stay right at the fork, follow signs for Superior/Hayward and merge onto US 53 North
8. Turn right onto Hwy 63N signs for Hayward/Ashland (approx. 37.9 miles)
9. Turn right onto County Hwy M/Pine Street (approx. 9.6 miles)
10. Turn left onto Lost Land Lake Rd (0.6 miles) Turn right onto Garmisch Resort Rd (0.4 miles, resort will be on your left)

### **Parking: Parking at resort down by beach for trailers.**

We are staying at Garmisch Resort again this year. Please contact them directly for lodging. Feel free to self-organize and rent cabins or houses. Individual rooms are available in the main lodge.
